MINUTES OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF BADMINTON ASSOCIATION OF INDIA HELD ON SATURDAY THE 31ST MAY, 2025 AT THE GRAND HOTEL, NEW DELHI

The Annual General Meeting of Badminton Association of India was held on 31st May, 2025 (Saturday) at The Grand Hotel, New Delhi. There were Sixty-seven (67) delegates from the Affiliated State Associations / Affiliated Units, as per enclosed Annexure-A.

Hon'ble President, Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma warmly welcomed all the representatives from the Affiliated Units in the Annual General Meeting of Badminton Association of India and took up the agenda items wise.

Agenda-1: Confirmation of the Minutes of the last Annual General Meeting held on 21st July, 2024 at Hotel Taj Vivanta, Guwahati:

Hon'ble President mentioned that the Minutes of the last Annual General Meeting held on 21st July, 2024 were circulated to all the members. Since no observations were received, the Minutes were passed unanimously duly proposed by Shri Ajay Kumar Singhania, Vice President, BAI and seconded by Sri Omar Rashid, Jt. Secretary, BAI.

Agenda-2: To approve the Annual Report for the year 2024-25:

Hon'ble President briefed the members about the Annual Report for the year 2024-25 that mentions about the achievements of Indian Badminton Players who bought a total of 209 medals in Sr. Category and 66 medals in Jr. Category in International circuit, the programs conducted by BAI for Coaches / Technical Officials / Umpires, Badminton Awardees, International Events hosted in India, Performance of Players in National Championships and about NCE, Guwahati and requested the House to pass the same.

The Annual Report was then passed unanimously duly proposed by Sri Sekhar C. Biswas, Vice President, BAI and seconded by Sri Anil K Choughule, Jt. Secretary, BAI.

Agenda-3: To approve the Audited Financial Statements, including Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure Accounts, for the year 2024-25:

Hon'ble President mentioned that the Audited Financial Statements, including Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure Accounts, for the year 2024-25 were adopted in the Executive Committee Meeting today and circulated to all members. He advised Sri Ram Avtar Sharma, OSD – Finance to inform the house about the Association's current financial position.

Sri Ram Avtar Sharma apprised the House of the details of the Income and Expenditure and the Balance Sheet, including the sponsorship amounts received with the support of the Hon'ble President, BAI.

Hon'ble President was very happy to inform the House about the Association's financial stability and growth. He informed that BAI had a Fixed Deposit worth Rs. 17.5 Crores, which if encashed today would amount to Rs. 20 Crores. BAI has its own established office in New Delhi. About the sponsorship agreement, he mentioned that this year BAI has signed Sponsorship Agreement worth Rs. 20.10 Crores annually with Yonex/Sunrise. The Contract is for Three (3) years. He further mentioned that Association is consistently receiving financial support from various Public Sector Units for organizing international tournaments in India. BAI had applied for a CRISIL rating to initiate the process of applying for CSR funds and it is a matter of delight that the Badminton Association of India has received a VO 1A grading from CRISIL, indicating very strong delivery capability and high financial proficiency.

The Audited Financial Statements, including Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure Accounts, for the year 2024-25 was then unanimously passed, proposed by Sri Prabhakar Rao, Jt. Secretary, BAI and seconded by Sri K.K. Sharma, Jt. Secretary, BAI.

Agenda-4: To appoint Statutory Auditors for the year 2025-26:

It was unanimously decided that M/s. Panigrahi & Associates, Chartered Accountants, Nagpur may be continued as Auditor for the financial year 2025-26 and the following resolution was taken:

"Resolved that M/s. SK Panigrahi & Associates, Chartered Accountants, Nagpur be and is hereby appointed as Statutory Auditors of the Association for the Financial Year 2025-26 at a remuneration to be mutually agreed between the Association and the Auditors."

Agenda-5: Post facto approval of the BAI Calendar for the year 2025-26:

Sh. Sekhar C. Biswas informed that the Annual Calendar is supposed to be passed in the Annual General Meeting. However, since there was constant pressure from SAI to submit the Annual Calendar, the Tournament Committee of BAI had finalised the Annual Calendar for the current year for submission to SAI and circulated on 21st March, 2025 to all Affiliated Units. He mentioned that the Annual Calendar needs to be ratified in the AGM as per norms.

The Annual Calendar issued on 21st March, 2025 was ratified by the members unanimously.

Hon'ble President informed the House that because of the better financial stability, we have revised the financial support extended by BAI and read the chart as follows-

Agenda-6: Any other matter with the permission of the Chair:

- A. Sri Sekhar C. Biswas, Vice President, BAI apprised the House that a Tournament Committee Meeting took place on 30th May, 2025 at The Grand Hotel, New Delhi and the decisions taken therein were approved in the EC meeting held just before the AGM. Executive Committee had passed all the suggestions as under (except the increase of Tournament Entry Fees):
- All Affiliated Units will be responsible for collection of entry fees of their players for all National Ranking Badminton Tournaments and forward the entry fees through DD / online to the Organizers. If there is a withdrawal of Players within withdrawal date, entry fees will not be required.
 - E-Participation and Merit Certificates for Players to be introduced for National Ranking Tournaments as well as for all the Team Members (including coaches and manager) for National Championships.
 - For participation in National Championships and Zonal Championships, Organizers to pay Lump Sum amount of Rs. 500/- per member of the teams towards expenses for arrival and departure from Airport / Railway Station / Bus Stand to Accommodation place & back. However, if any Organizer want to arrange transport for the Teams for arrival & departure, that has to be notified in advance. In any case as per present norms transportation To & Fro from Hotel to Venue and back will have to be provided by the Organizers.
 - National Ranking draws will henceforth be made in BAI Office within 72 hours from the date of publishing the Final M&Q list. Draws will be shown LIVE through YouTube and Video recording will be made to have full transparency. Draws for National Championships and Zonal Championships will be made in the Venue as per present norms through BAI YouTube Channel.
 - Entries for participation in international events will be forwarded by BAI for players who are within the BWF Rank of 150 and BAI Rank 100. Entries to be forwarded through Affiliated Units within due time already notified.

Due to huge increase in price of Shuttlecocks, he informed that there was a recommendation for increase of entry fees, but as per the advice of the Hon'ble President the increase of entry fees was deferred to be reviewed after about three (3) months.

The House approved all the recommendations (Sl. No. i to Sl.No. v).

- B. Sri K.K. Sharma, Chairman, Age Fraud Committee mentioned that there was an Age Fraud Committee Meeting held on 31st May, 2025 at the Hotel Grand, New Delhi. He informed that by adopting various SOPs, almost 60% Age Fraud cases have been controlled. He mentioned that Age Fraud Committee recommended to allow Voluntary Age Rectification Scheme (VARS) for another time for the players who have an existing BAI ID but is having an incorrect date of birth and/or discrepancy in their Date of Birth/age. After hearing from the members, Hon'ble President mentioned that the scheme may be opened for a period of Two (2) months with a fee of Rs. 5000/- to be paid to BAI along with applications.

- C. Sri Ve Arunachalam requested that the VARS process be considered for veteran players as well. However, the Hon'ble General Secretary clarified that age manipulation had already been a concern among some individuals during their time in the junior category, and extending VARS to the veterans could potentially lead to similar misuse. Therefore, the request could not be accepted.
- D. Sri Robin Hibu, Sr. Vice President, Arunachal State Badminton Association praised the Hon'ble President for his passion for development of badminton. He suggested that an annual magazine may be released, reflecting the overall activities and progress of Badminton sport throughout the year. He also proposed that a common SOP may be laid down for the conduct of international tournaments in India to ensure uniformity as well as proper security measures. Hony. General Secretary appreciated the suggestion and informed that BAI will endeavour to release an e-magazine quarterly highlighting all achievements and activities of Badminton.
- E. Sri Ajay Kumar Singhanian informed the House about two (2) achievements from the Badminton fraternity --- One (1) is Ms. Kuhoo Garg, an international women badminton player has successfully cleared the UPSC examination and has become an IPS officer and Sri S. Muralidharan, Vice President, BAI, has received Dronacharya (Lifetime) Award in recognition of his outstanding contributions in the field of Badminton Sport.
- F. Sri G.L. Verma, Airports Authority of India mentioned that from last 25 years they had been providing financial support to badminton players who have brought laurels to the country by winning National and International medals. He requested that their team may kindly be allowed to participate in BAI tournaments, though the employment offered to the Players on contract basis. The Hon'ble President mentioned that the suggestion of Airport Authority of India has been noted and a decision will be communicated shortly in consultation with the Executive Committee Members.
- G. Shri Manoj Patil, President, Goa Badminton Association reiterated his earlier request for establishing a National Centre of Excellence in Goa. Hon'ble President mentioned that his vision is to establish regional centers across the country and also mentioned that for establishing the National Centre of Excellence, the Agreement between BAI and Govt. of Assam will be shared so that the requirement for establishing National Centre of Excellence is known to all by following a similar model of Agreement. Any State Unit can come forward but they have to fulfill the requirement.

Sri Manoj Patil wanted some relaxation of the existing norms for participation in International Tournaments which is at present TOP 100 BWF Rank of Indian Players. He requested that the norms for BWF Rank for International Entry may please be allowed upto BWF 200 Rank. Hon'ble President mentioned that in the EC Meeting which was held just before the AGM it has already been decided that BWF Rank upto 150 and BAI Rank upto 100 will be considered for sending entries in the international events. As earlier discussed, the same was approved in the AGM as well.

- H. Sri Praveen Shenoy from Goa requested to consider allowing players to participate in the leagues conducted by them taking players from the adjoining States also. Hony. General Secretary mentioned that State Leagues should be restricted to players from their Districts within the particular State. Any player from other States if participate in any league conducted by other State will be deemed as

unauthorized participation. He also mentioned that the Zonal leagues can be conducted with prior written permission from BAI and only the players from that particular zone can participate. Sri Omar Rashid, Jt. Secretary, BAI also supported the request. Hon'ble President also agreed to the proposal and requested that care be taken to ensure these tournaments do not clash with the BAI calendar.

On the query of Sri Praveen Shanoy about the PBL, Hon'ble President informed that the party with whom the Agreement was made had failed to conduct the leagues from 2021 onwards. Despite various reminders from BAI, they have not cleared the outstanding dues also. He further pointed out that match-fixing also is a significant concern for such leagues which is challenging to manage. He mentioned that BCCI has a strict mechanism to address these issues effectively. In view of such issues, even Indian Players have not shown interest in re-starting the PBL. Hon'ble President advised Sri Bamang Tago who was involved with a team in PBL to share his experience about match-fixing during the league. Sri Bamang Tago expressed that during the PBL he had seen that several players intentionally not performing which clearly showed that there was match-fixing. Hon'ble President mentioned that before deciding any Badminton League, BAI has to establish a robust mechanism so that match-fixing can be stopped.

I. Sri Rajesh Reddy made following submissions:

- TDS on Prize Money is a burden on State Associations. BAI may consider bearing the TDS.
- Quantity of Shuttlecocks may be increased for Ranking Tournaments considering the huge increase in price of shuttlecocks.
- A Foreign Coach for one week / SAI Coach may be deputed to Bengaluru.

Hon'ble President mentioned that paying Prize Money during the Tournaments is prerogative to State Associations, but considering KBA has some issues since they are running a club, BAI may send the Prize Money to Players which are being conducted by KBA, subject to the condition that a formal request letter is submitted to BAI in advance.

Regarding additional shuttlecocks, Sri Sekhar C. Biswas mentioned that whatever shuttlecocks are given by Yonex/Sunrise are being distributed for National Rankings and Championships and in fact, at the end of the year BAI has to purchase additional shuttlecocks for Tournaments and Championships. In this context, Hon'ble President mentioned that it is a fact that cost of shuttlecocks has increased hugely and there was a recommendation from the Tournament Committee to increase the entry fees which will be reviewed in about three (3) months' time.

For deputation of coach, Hon'ble President informed that the coaches are being appointed by SAI on their payroll and posted only in the National Camp Centres.

- Sri Vikram Singh Sisodiya, newly elected President, Chhattisgarh Badminton Association applauded Hon'ble President for his continuous efforts towards promotion of Badminton in India. He also briefed the members about the ongoing activities and initiatives of the Chhattisgarh Badminton Association towards promotion of Badminton.
