- Who is entitled to enter?** Players from Associations which are Badminton Asia Members, Associate Members of the BWF that are from Asia and associations which have been recognised by the BWF before the integration of Para-Badminton into the BWF are entitled to enter. **Entries must be in writing on the official forms.**
- Entry Deadline** The entry must be received no later than **Monday 24 September 2012.**
- The doubles / mixed partner must be named at the same time.

- Entry Fee**
- \$70.00 USD per player, trainer, team manager and physiotherapist.
 - \$60.00 USD for each accompanying person.

The entry fees include the organisation payment and the shuttle bus service.
Note: The entry fees do not include lunch at the competition venue. **The lunch at the competition venue is included in the hotel fees.**

The fee must be paid with the entry. The entry fee is **not-refundable** – and will not be refunded should the player not show up or the player withdrawals after 24 September 2012.

Who can play Players can play only if they are able to present a valid BWF Classification licence (they have an official BWF Classification) or they take part in the classification process before the tournament starts. In the entry form, state your Competition Class and Competition Status.

Classification Classification will be in accordance with BWF Classification Regulations – see General Competition Regulations – Appendix 12 ([linked here](#)).

Regulations The matches will be played in accordance with BWF Laws of Badminton - see the BWF website www.bwfbadminton.org ([linked here](#))

Players must be ready to play 30 minutes before the schedule time of their match.

Umpires Umpires will officiate all matches.
The umpires will be appointed in agreement with the BWF. The organizer offers accommodation, food and transport for a maximum of four (4) international umpires. Umpires must be entered with the team.
